



CITY OF WALLED LAKE BRANCH CHIPPING PROGRAM

The City of Walled Lake Department of Public Services (DPS) provides a monthly branch chipping service to residents throughout the City beginning the **first Monday of April** through the **first Monday of November**. The DPS will chip branches **no smaller than 2” in diameter**. Please leave branches **as long as possible**. Place branches at the curb with **cut edges toward the road and stacked neatly**.

The City does NOT chip trees or brush. Please hire a private contractor to remove trees or large piles. **The City is unable to chip stumps, roots, small hedges, spindly branches, or branches that are twisted, gnarled, or have a large “V” fork. Please place these items in a brown paper ward waste bag or a 32-gallon container clearly marked “yard waste,” as the pieces will not feed through the chipper.**

Your brush was NOT picked up today (or partially picked up) because of one or more of the following:

- Branches were not placed neatly at the curb with the cut edges toward the road.
- Stumps
- Roots were not cut off
- Items were small, spindly, trimmings or clippings – yard waste
- Branches are twisted and gnarled, or had a large “V” fork

Please note of this problem and correct it for next month’s pickup.
