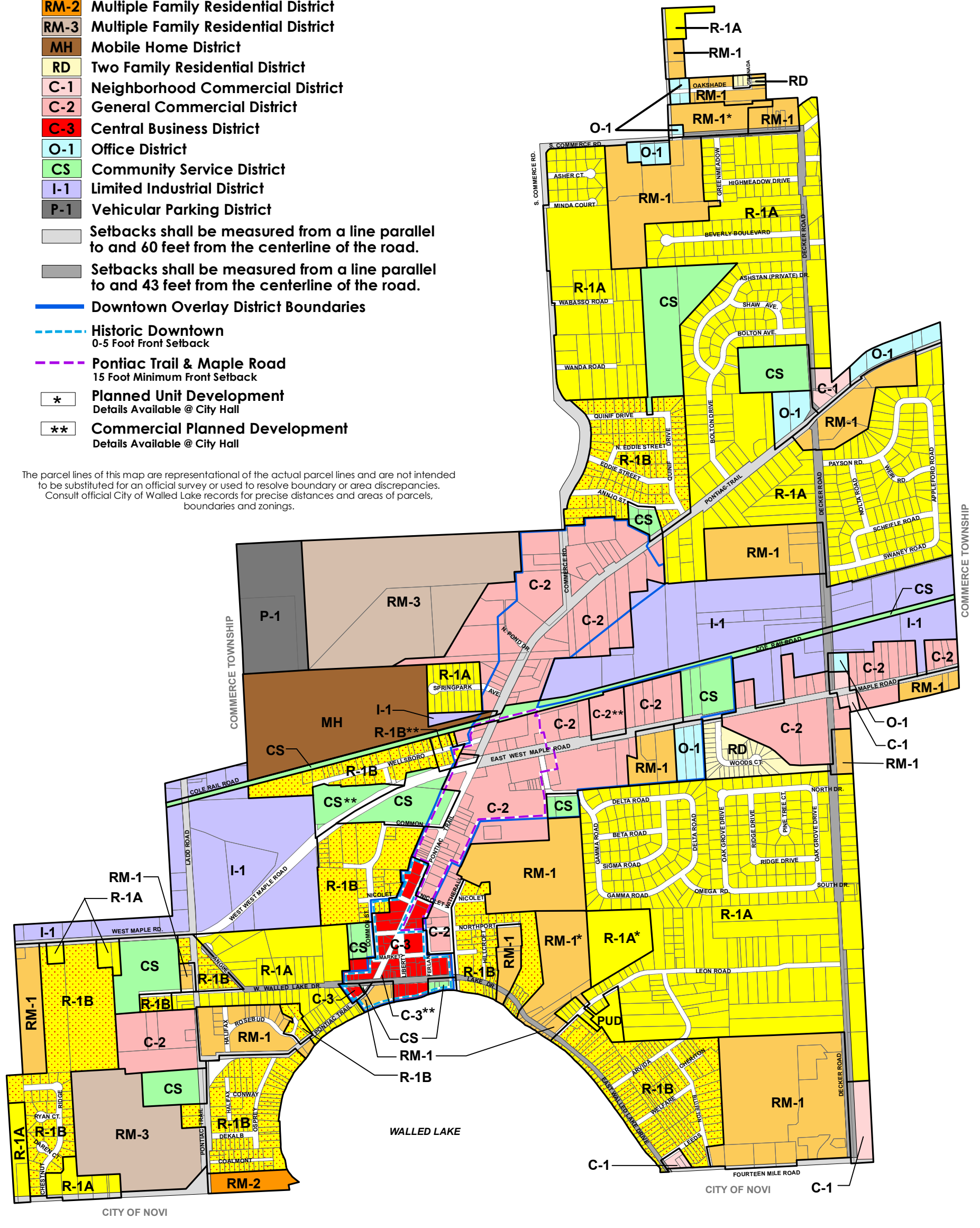


City of Walled Lake, Michigan Zoning Map
