




# for Homeowner



At least 6 in. of <u>spliced or unspliced</u> conductor, measured from the point in the box where the conductors enter the enclosure, must be provided for conductor splices or terminations.



Boxes with openings of less than 8 in. must have at least 6 in. of conductor, measured from the point where the conductors enter the box, and at least 3 in. of conductor outside the box.




1.4 m (4½ ft) and within 300 mm (12 in.) of every cable entry into enclosures such as outlet boxes, junction boxes, cabinets, or fittings

300 mm (12 in.) measurement is still measured from the box to the securing method (staples; cable ties, straps, hangers, etc.), but cable length between the cable entry and the closest cable support must not exceed 450 mm (18 in.)



### Check Sheets For Residential and Other Locations Listed



406.12 Tamper-Resistant Receptacles

MRC E4002.14

All 15- and 20-ampere, 125- and 250-volt non locking-type receptacles in areas specified in 406.12(1) through (7) must be listed tamper-resistant receptacles:

- (1) Dwelling units in all areas specified in 210.52 and 550.13;
- (2) Guest rooms and guest suites of hotels and motels;
- (3) Child care facilities
- (4) Preschools/elementary educational facilities;
- (5) Waiting rooms, etc. in medical/dental offices;
- (6) Places of waiting-transportation, gymnasiums, etc.;
- (7) Dormitories
