Plans are required for all building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant of Act. No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended and shall bear that architect's or engineer's signature and seal, except:

- 1. One and two family dwellings less than 3,500 square feet.
- 2. Alterations and repair work determined by the electrical official to be of a minor nature.
- 3. When an electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps.
- 4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

5. Applicant Signature

6. Homeowner Affidavit

A PERMIT WILL BE CANCELLED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION.
