





- Please Note: Kid vendors are responsible for bringing their own table to display their items. A tent is not required for this event date, but it is strongly encouraged, as the Market area does not offer shade. Tents must be safely weighted down.
- Kid Vendors will be loading and unloading directly from the Parking Lot. Wagons may be used for transporting market equipment and materials.
- Kid Vendors must arrive between 9:00 9:30 AM to set up and be ready to sell by 10:00 AM.
- Vendors must remain for the entire market day until 2:00 PM.
- The Market takes place RAIN or SHINE

What Can You Sell?



We encourage creativity! Below is a list of approved items to be sold. All products and services must be approved by the Market Manager before the event.

- Handmade crafts or jewelry
- Artwork or prints
- Baked Goods (Items produced under the Cottage Food Law may be sold as long as proper labeling and food safety handling practices are followed. All food items to be sold must be labeled according to Michigan Cottage Food Law http://www.michigan.gov/cottagefood. Please contact the Market Manager with any questions.)
- Creative services (face painting, games, etc.)

Business Behavior:

- Market participants are expected to treat vendors, customers, and market staff in a respectful and professional manner.
- No vendor shall refuse to permit the purchase of any produce, goods, or participation based on race, religion, color, creed, gender, political affiliation, sexual orientation, national origin, sex, age, marital status, gender-identity, height, weight or mental or physical ability.
