PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
TUESDAY, AUGUST 6, 2024**

To the Qualified Electors of the CITY OF WALLED LAKE, County of Oakland:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Walled Lake who is not already registered, may register to vote at the office of the City Clerk; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office or website www.expressSOS.com, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, July 22, 2024**.

After this date, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in-person with proof of residency (MCL 168.492) at the City of Walled Lake Clerk’s office, located at 1499 E. West Maple, Walled Lake, MI 48390.

EARLY VOTING SCHEDULE

Days – Early Voting is open nine (9) consecutive days beginning Saturday, July 27, 2024 the second Saturday before the election, and ending on Sunday, August 4, 2024, the Sunday before the election.

Time – Early Voting is 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. except Thursday when the hours are noon to 8:00 p.m.

AND FOR THE PURPOSE of voting on the Walled Lake Library Millage Renewal for the City of Walled Lake

This millage will enable the continued operations of the Walled Lake City Library. If approved this would be a renewal of the current library millage levy as rolled back by the Headlee Amendment.

Shall the City of Walled Lake be authorized to levy a tax annually upon the taxable value of all property subject to ad valorem taxation in an amount not to exceed one (1) mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value), of which .8574 mills is a renewal of the previous voter authorized millage as rolled back by the Headlee Amendment and .1426 mills is a new millage, for a period of ten (10) years, 2025 through 2034, inclusive, which will raise in the first year of such tax levy an estimated \$288,000, for the purpose of providing funds for all library purposes permitted by law.
