Al Riley, a local gas station owner and Optimist, transferred ownership of his land, now known as Riley Park, to the Walled Lake Optimist's Club. On October 19, 1971, the Walled Lake Optimist's Club donated Riley Field to the City of Walled Lake. The park, previously known as Riley Field, remained a popular baseball and softball field for many years prior to the re-location of the Banks-DolbeerBradley-Foster Farmhouse to this location.
